## BOUT your newborn photo session

A newborn session is perfect for those who would like a collection of timeless emotive images captured in a documentary storytelling style. These sessions take between 1 to 2.5 hours to allow for feeding and settling. Newborn sessions are done in the comfort of your home or outdoors and on location depending on weather. If indoors I ask that you choose a room with ample daylight, for example one with a large window. Please make sure the room is very warm. I provide a few prop options and swaddles, but these will only be used at your request. I will ask for some posing and it's important that you and your baby feel comfortable. In the years to come you will love looking back on these precious and fleeting moments in your sweet baby's life.





I like to photograph your new baby between 7-14 days, while they are still nice and sleepy and easy to photograph. I will make a tentative booking based on your baby's due date. I will wait to hear from you once your little one arrives and we will put an official date on the calendar.




## PREING & what's included

A 1 to 2.5 hour session in your home or location of your choice. 40+ professionally finished high resolution digital images presented in a password protected online gallery for you to download and share. Swaddles and a few props are provided and brought to your session.
